
In support of this Motion, Claimants submit, as more fully described in the accompanying Memorandum of Points and Authorities in support of this final approval motion and the supporting declarations and exhibits, that this settlement represents a fair, reasonable, and adequate compromise of the claims asserted in the First Amended Demand for Class Arbitration in that it provides significant benefits to the Settlement Class in exchange for releases of claims to Respondent relating directly to the claims asserted in the operative Demand, as set forth in detail in the Settlement Agreement previously submitted to the Arbitrator.

McFerrin of the McFerrin Law Firm, LLC, Alex Thomas of Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC ("KCC"), the Arbitrator-appointed settlement administrator, filed in support of this Motion, the moving papers filed in support of the accompanying application for payment of attorneys' fees, reimbursement of expenses and Class Representative

awards, the Proposed Award Granting Final Approval, and all other papers filed and proceedings had in this action and any other written and oral arguments that may be presented to the Arbitrator.
