TO: ALL PARTIES AND TO THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on November 15, 2017 at 11:00 a.m., before Mr. Robert L. Brent, at The Orrick Building, 405 Howard Street, San Francisco, California 94105, the Class Representatives, by and through their undersigned counsel of record, will and hereby do move for an order approving the award of attorneys' fees, reimbursement of litigation expenses, and payment of incentive awards to the Class Representatives, consistent with the agreement of the parties as reflected in the Settlement Agreement on file with the Arbitrator and the subsequent agreement of the Parties.

This Motion is made on the grounds that approval of an award of attorneys' fees, reimbursement of litigation expenses, and payment of incentive awards is proper given that the Parties have agreed that Class Counsel may make such applications in their Stipulation and Agreement of Settlement and Release (the "Settlement Agreement"), the work of Class Counsel and the Class Representatives has conferred substantial benefits to the Class, and that such awards are permitted under the American Arbitration Association's Rules as well as California and federal law.

This Motion is based on the Arbitrator's August 16, 2017 Order Granting Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement and Directing Dissemination of Class Notice Program and the papers submitted in support of that Motion (which are incorporated herein by reference), this Notice of Motion and Motion, the accompanying Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the Declarations of both Claimants' Counsel and of the Class Representatives filed in support of this Motion, the moving papers and Declarations filed in support of the accompanying motion for an award granting final approval of settlement, and any other written and oral arguments that may be presented to the Arbitrator.
